

Crash Course for NTSE Selection Year, 2017-18*(For students of Class X)***Program Focus & Objectives:**

An ideal program developed keeping into the constraint of time available for preparation for **NTSE stage - I** for the students who wish to climb the ladder of success from class X itself. National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) is the most prestigious Scholarship Exam for school studying students. **Students of class X can appear in this exam and win scholarships for their entire Academic Career.**

This program helps the student in understanding the basics of Science & Mathematics. Absolute clarity of concepts helps in increasing the IQ & reasoning ability and developing a strong foundation that is so essential for success in the career.

What is NTSE?

The National Talent Search Examination (NTSE) is a National Level scholarship program in India to identify and nurture talented students. It honours and helps talented students by providing financial assistance in the form of a monthly scholarship for the entire Academic Career. Students studying in Class X are eligible to appear for the selection process. As it is organized by an official body (NCERT), it is widely regarded as the most prestigious examination at high school level in India. There is a two-stage selection process for award of scholarship. For Stage - I, selection will be done by States/UTs through the written examination. Each State/Union Territory has been allotted a quota to recommend a specific number of candidates for the Stage - II examination, the details of which are available on NCERT website (www.ncert.nic.in). Students who qualify Stage - I will be eligible to appear for Stage - II examination conducted by NCERT.

Why should I appear in NTSE?

NTSE is one of the oldest and most prestigious scholarship exams in India. An NTSE scholar commands tremendous respect in the society. Around 1000 NTSE Scholars are finally awarded scholarships based on Stage – II.

It honours and helps talented students by providing financial assistance in the form of a monthly scholarship. The scholarships under the present scheme are awarded to the candidates for pursuing courses in sciences and social sciences up to doctoral level and in professional courses like medicine and engineering up to second-degree level subject to the fulfillment of the conditions.

The Pattern of Written Examination:

Note: The official notification of NTSE Selection Year 2017-18 has not been released yet. Following pattern of written examination is of last year.

Stage - I examination at the State / UT level will comprise of three parts, namely (a) Mental Ability Test (MAT) and (b) Language Test (LT) and (C) Scholastic Ability Test (SAT).

Stage - II examination at the National Level will also comprise of three parts, (a) Mental Ability Test (MAT) and (b) Language Test (LT) and (C) Scholastic Ability Test (SAT).

At Stage – II (National Level), there will be negative marking in each paper. For each wrong answer 1/3 marks will be deducted. No marks will be deducted for unattempted questions.

Course Structure:

- ❖ Entire course will be covered in **2 Phases with National Phase Tests**.
- ❖ Subject wise packages. Additional problems will be supplemented wherever necessary. Students should not require any additional books etc.

- ❖ **Two Tests of All India Open Test Series for Target NTSE 2017-18** will be provided. (I.e. Part Test IV on 3rd Oct 2017 & Full Test on 23rd Oct 2017).
- ❖ Students also gain important exam practice through quizzes, phase tests & mock tests (conducted in a simulated environment giving the students a 'feel' of the real exam) that can help them improve their examination temperament - a necessary element for success in any competitive exam.
- ❖ Regular feedbacks & test analysis sessions.
- ❖ **Online Test Series for NTSE through www.mypat.in** - myPAT is an Online Platform for Learning through Assessment, Analysis, Identification of Knowledge Gaps and Remedy Options. myPAT empowers you with your own Subject Concept Coverage Meter, Performance Meter and Success Meter. It also enables higher learning outcome, building exam temperament & readiness and ensures success in competitive exams.

Exam Date: 20th August, 2017

Exam Timing: 3:30 pm – 6:00 pm

Exam Schedule & Pattern:

Objective Paper : There will be two sections (i) SAT (90 Minutes) which will consist of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Maths and Social Science and (ii) MAT (50 Minutes) which will consist of questions of Mental Ability with verbal, non-verbal reasoning.

Note: Actual duration for answering Paper will be 2 hours 20 minutes. First 10 minutes will be provided for filling up the information on the answer OMR sheet and for reading the examination instructions. Apply on prescribed Application form (collect from nearest FIITJEE centre) with two passport size colour photographs, along with a Demand Draft / Pay Oder of the **Registration Fee of Rs. 200/-** (inclusive of GST).
