for Excellence in Junior Science Talent Search Exam - JSTSE (for Class IX Students)

Program Focus & Objectives:

An ideal program developed keeping into the constraint of time available for preparation for **JSTSE** for the students who wish to climb the ladder of success from class IX itself. Junior Science Talent Search Examination (JSTSE) is the most prestigious Scholarship Exam for Class IX students studying in schools of Delhi. This program helps the student in understanding the basics of Science & Mathematics and General Awareness. Absolute clarity of concepts helps in increasing the IQ & reasoning ability and developing a strong foundation that is so essential for success in one's career.

What is JSTSE?

Junior Science Talent Search Examination or JSTSE is conducted by Science Branch of Education, Delhi and is scheduled to be conducted on 16th December, 2018. 150 scholarships are allotted every year under JSTSE. Any student from a recognized school (Govt. /Govt. Aided / Public / KV / Navodaya / NDMC) in Delhi, currently in IX and has secured minimum 65% marks in VIII can apply for JSTSE. The last exam was held on 28th January, 2018.

Why should I appear in JSTSE?

JSTSE is one of the most prestigious scholarship exams. A JSTSE scholar commands tremendous respect in the society. It provides students with an opportunity to appear in a Govt. / State recognized scholastic exam very early in his / her academic learning. Thus, giving an opportunity to stay ahead in the competition.

It also honours and helps talented students by providing financial assistance in the form of a scholarship.

The Pattern of Written Examination:

Note: The official notification regarding the pattern of JSTSE this year has not been released yet. Following pattern of written examination has been taken from last year.

The Examination consists of two papers

1. General Knowledge -

No. of Questions – 50, Marks – 50 and Time Allotted – 50 Mins

2. General Science and Mathematics -

No. of Questions – 150, Marks – 150 and Time Allotted – 150 Mins

Course Structure:

- ❖ Entire course will be covered in **2 Phases with phase tests**.
- ❖ Subjects Covered will be Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, & General Knowledge.
- ❖ Subject wise packages and additional problems will be supplemented wherever necessary. Students should not require any additional books etc.
- ❖ Students also gain important exam practice through quizzes, phase tests & mock tests (conducted in a simulated environment giving the students a 'feel' of the real exam) that can help them improve their examination temperament - a necessary element for success in any competitive exam.

- ❖ Regular feedbacks & test analysis sessions.
- ❖ Dedicated Academic Operations team provides feedback at any point of time apart from scheduled parent teacher meetings.

Duration:

- ❖ **Approx. 165 hrs.** including classroom interaction and about 24 hrs of testing time (**7 tests each of 3 hrs 20 minutes duration**)

Class Schedule & Frequency

Classes will be held for about 3-4 days in a week from 4:00 pm to 7:30 pm

Course Commencement Date

First Week of September, 2018

The program will run till the second week of December, 2018.

Exam Schedule & Pattern:

Objective Paper: There will be two sections

Section 1 – IQ Duration – 30 Mins. No. of Questions – 30 Total Marks – 30 (1 Mark each)

Section 2 – Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics

Duration – 120 Mins.

No. of Questions – 20 each for P, C & M (Total 60 questions) Total Marks – 120 (2 Marks each)

Apply on prescribed Application form (collect from nearest FIITJEE centre) with two passport size colour photographs, along with a Demand Draft / Pay Order of the **Registration Fee of Rs. 200/-** (inclusive of GST).
